## Election announcement

All students at Clausthal University of Technology are invited to cast their votes in the elections for the Student Parliament, the Student Representative Councils and the Foreigners' Council.

## Voting procedure

Voting will take place

**Monday, 15.01.2024, 2 p.m. to Monday, 29.01.2024, 2 p.m. in electronic form**

Votes will be cast in electronic form. This is possible during the above-mentioned period via any computer that is connected to the online voting portal via the Internet. The electronic ballot paper must be completed and sent electronically in accordance with the instructions contained in the election letter and in the election portal. You will be provided with more detailed information on voting access and the conduct of the election in good time before the start of the elections. Every person entitled to vote must cast their vote personally on the electronic ballot paper by marking a cross in the space provided next to the name of each candidate. In the case of list voting, each eligible voter has one vote, whereby the vote for one candidate also counts in favor of the entire list. In the case of a majority vote, as many candidates can be elected as there are seats in the group; the accumulation of votes for one candidate is invalid. Each ballot paper contains a note to this effect. I hereby call on all eligible voters at Clausthal University of Technology to exercise their right to vote. I would like to point out that only those who are entered in the electoral register are entitled to vote.

At its meeting on January 5, 2024, the Student Election Committee of Clausthal University of Technology approved the nominations listed in the annex.

In accordance with Section 8 (2) sentence 1 SWO, the election must be held in accordance with the principles of majority voting:

- Student Council Physics, Materials Science, Chemistry
- Student Council Mathematics Computer Science
- Student Council for Economics
- Student Council Mechanical Engineering, Process Engineering & Chemical Engineering ( No elections)
- Student Council Geo-, Energy & Raw Materials ( No elections)
- Council for Foreigners ( No elections)
